




No record of subsequent monumentation found in Union County survey records.



Set a steel fencepost approximately 5 feet South with 54-9 sign attached

A 21 inch Ponderosa Pine bears South 86° East, a distance of 47.65 feet, with a healed blaze.

A 23 inch Ponderosa Pine bears South 11° West, a distance of 27.09 feet, with a healed blaze.


