
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment: Corner originally established by Henry M. Thatcher under GLO contract number 320 dated April 1, 1879. Surveyor General record states:

Set stone 15x13x5 for 4 sec cor from which;

A black pine 9 in dia bears N150W 9 lks dist A black pine 10 in dia bears S80W 30 lks dist



No record of subsequent monumentation found in county records

Description of corner evidence found:

Found a stone 14x11x4 inches marked 4 S in small mound of stone

Found remains of Lodgepole Pine $S8^{\circ}W$ 30 lks dead down and rotting with scribes visible Found remains of Lodgepole Pine $N15^{\circ}W$ 9 lks rotted, found slab of wood with BT scribe visible

Description of monument and accessories lestablished to perpetuate the original location of this corner: In place of stone, I set a $2^{\frac{1}{2}}x30^{\frac{1}{2}}$ aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown 28 inches in the ground from which:

New BTs A 13 inch diameter Tamarack bears N57°E 17.58 feet marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S26 BT A 16 inch diameter Tamarack bears S48°E 13.70 feet marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S35 BT

Buried the original stone South and alongside of monument Set steel fencepost approximately 5 feet North with 54-9 sign attached
