
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At position determined by survey number 031-2000, 1 set a 24''x30'' aluminum pipa with aluminum cap marked as shown, 26" in the ground from which:

NEW BEARING TREES:

A 17 inch diameter Ponderosa Pine bears South 71° East, a distance of 89.40 feet marked C 1/4 S31 BT

A 10 inch diameter Ponderosa Pine bears South 24° East, a distance of 123.00 feet marked X BT $\,$

A 13 inch diameter Ponderosa Pine bears South 3° West, a distance of 105.26 feet marked C 1/4 S31 BT

A 15 inch diameter Ponderosa Pine bears North 81° West, a distance of 46.15 feet marked C 1/4 S31 BT

Raised a small mound of stone around monument. Set a steel fence post approximately 1 feet West of the corner monument.
