CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Corner was established in 1882, by Rufusts. Moore, under General Land Office Contract No. 451. Surveyor General's records state: Set a basalt stone 17" x 9" x 7" - 12" in ground for \(\frac{1}{4} \) sec. cor. marked \(\frac{1}{4} \) on North face, from which:

A pine 6" dia. bears N 67 W, 8 lks. dist. marked \(\frac{1}{4} \) BT.

A pine 6" dia. bears S 82 E, 11 lks. dist. marked \(\frac{1}{4} \) BT.

Description of corner evidence found:

At assumed corner location I found no acceptable evidence of stone as previously described, however I did find the remains and traces of the scribing $\frac{1}{4}$ S BT on both bearing trees lying on the ground, and could determine the original location of both bearing trees.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

As the evidence in the vicinity of the corner agrees with the GLO original record, at the location reconstructed from the position of the original bearing trees, I set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " brass cap on a 30" galv. iron pipe and being stamped as shown above in the ground, with a large mound of stone around the monument.

New bearing trees:
A doug fir 12" dia. bears N 86 W, 34.94 feet and acribed \$\frac{1}{4}\$S S 8 BT.
A doug fir 12" dia. bears N 58 E, 9.68 feet and scribed \$\frac{1}{4}\$S S 9 BT.
