A pine 42" dia. bears N 51 E, 141 lks. dist. marked

A pine 10" dia. bears N 60 W, 90 lks. dist. marked T 5 S R 34 E S 17 BT.

A fir 9" dia. bears S 62 W, 87 lks. dist. marked T 5 S R 34 E S 20 BT.

A pine 11" dia. bears S 14 E, 138 lks. dist. marked T 5 S R 34 E S 21 BT.

Description of corner evidence found:

At assumed corner location I found no trace of the wood post as described in the GLO record, though I did find a 1" iron pin at the corner location from which:

A pine 42" dia. bears N 51 E, 141 lks. dist. with the face being previously opened exposing the scribing; tree is alive and in good condition.

A pine approx. 30" dia. bears S 14 E, 138 lks. is dead and lying on the ground with a blaze healed over and being face down on the ground.

No evidence of the remaining 2 bearing trees in Sec's. 17 & 20.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

As the evidence in the vicinity of the corner agrees with the GLO record, at the location of the $\frac{1}{2}$ iron pin I set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ brass cap on a 30" galv. iron pipe, and being stamped as shown above, with a large mound of stone and dirt around, and of which buried the monument.

New bearing trees: A pine 18" dia. bears N 20 W, 154.54 feet scribed T 5 S R 34 E S 17 BT. A fir 9" dia. bears S 74 W, 126.03 feet scribed T 5 S R 34 E S 20 BT. A fir 10" dia. bears S 44 E, 94.50 feet scribed T 5 S R 34 E S 21 BT.
