Description of corner evidence found:

. 645

At assumed corner location I found no trace of the original $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. corner nor any evidence of the bearing trees as there was evidence of a fire in the early 1900's through this area and of which possibly destroyed all evidence of the original corner.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Assuming this corner to be lost, I then used single proportioning measurements to re-establish this $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., thus I set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ brass cap on a 30" galv. iron pipe, and being stamped as shown above, with a large mound of stone and dirt around, and of which buried the monument.

New bearing trees:
A tamarack 8" dia. bears N 36 W, 44.58 feet scribed \$\frac{1}{4}\$S S15 BT.
A fir 6" dia. bears S 43 W, 13.50 feet scribed \$\frac{1}{4}\$S S 22 BT.
