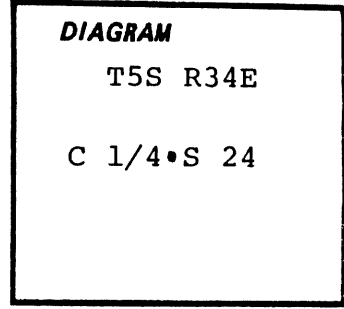


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

The original subdivision of T4S, R34E was by Rufus S. Moore under Contract No. 451, approved Feb. 1, 1884. But this was not an original GLO corner.



Description of corner evidence found:

No monument or evidence found.

Description of monument and accessories established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set 2.5" aluminum cap on 2 3/8"x30" aluminum pipe rising 8" above ground. Cap is stamped:  
Set steel fence post 3.0 ft. north of corner.

New BT's:

A 6" L. Pine bears S50°E, 18.2 ft., blazed and scribed: C 1/4 S24 BT.

A 7" L. Pine bears N20°W, 11.2 ft., blazed and scribed: C1/4 S24 BT.

Brass LS 1844 disc in lower end of blaze. Painted blazes and attached signs as per Standard Specifications for Cadastral Surveys, USFS Region 6, March 1982.

Compass Declination: 19 3/4°E

Corner is found in dense thicket just off southeast corner of clearing from CN 1/16. Road 5160-544 to Fly Creek. Walk South from CN 1/16.
