Description of monument and accessories i established to perpetuate the original location of this corner

At the position of the corner I set a 2" galvanized pipe 30" long with bronze cap on top and 8" plate welded to bottom. Pipe set 6" deep on rock and raised a stone monument.

I stamped the disk

From the monument the original bearing trees are-none:

I set two new bearing trees as follows;

A pine 9" in diam bears N15°E 26.5 ft dist marked \$SBT;

A pine 16" in diam bears S20°W 63.5 ft. dist marked \$SBT;

Distance measured to center of trees and marked with scribe.

I set a steel fence post with USFS sign 54-4 attached.

National Borest boundary signs were placed on the post indicating National Forest land to North and East. Bearing tree signs were placed on the bearing trees shoulder high facing the corner.
