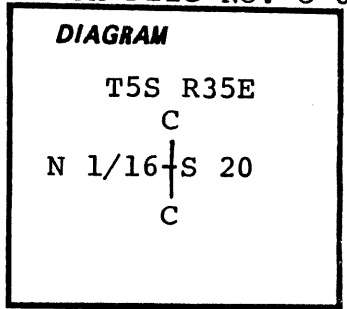


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

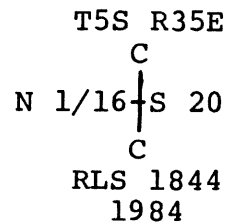
Description of corner evidence found:

Description of monument and accessories | established to perpetuate the original location of this corner: Cap is stamped:

Corner set by single proportioning.

Set a 2.5" aluminum cap on 2"x30" aluminum pipe rising 6" above ground. Set steel fence post 2.0 ft. north of corner.



New BT's:

A 6" L. Pine bears N37.5°E, 58.6 ft., blazed and scribed: CN 1/16 S20 BT.
a 6" L. Pine bears S75°E, 42.8 ft., blazed and scribed: CN 1/16 S20 BT.

Attached brass disk stamped LS 1844 to base of blazes. Painted blazes and attached signs as per Standard Specifications for Cadastral Surveys, USFS Region 6, March 1982.

Compass Declination: 19 1/2°E
