Description of corner evidence founds

Found a pine snag withscribe at N31°E 24 lks dist. In section 23 found a down log with scribe.



Description of manument and accessories I established to perpetuate the

original location of this corner

AT the position of the corner I set a 5" galvanized pipe 30" long with a bronze cap on top and 8" plate welded to bottom. The pipe set to a depth of 24" and back filled with stone and soil.

I stamped the disk

The original bearing trees are unsatisfactory.

I set new bearing trees as follows;

A fir 8" in diam bears N18°E 16.2 ft dist marked †SBT;

A fir 11" in diam bears N46°W 2616 ft. dist marked †SBT

Distance measured to center of tree and marked with scribe.

I set a steel fence post with USFS sign 54-4 attached. USFS bearing tree signs were placed on the bearing trees shoulder high facing the commer.
