
## CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

Corner set by subdivision of section. Set 2.5"x30" aluminum capped aluminum pipe rising 6" above ground. Set steel fence post 3.0 ft. west of corner.

New BT's:

6" P. Pine bears S74 3/4°W, 89.8 ft.,
blazed and scribed: CS 1/16 S24 BT.
14" P. Pine bears S23°W, 160.4 ft.,
blazed and scribed: CS 1/16 S24 BT.

Painted blazes and attached signs as per <u>Standard Specifications for Cadastral Surveys</u>, USFS Region 6, March 1982. Brass disk stamped "LS 1844" nailed to lower end of blazes.

To find corner, take road 51 north 1/4 mile from road 5125. Corner is on bare hilside, visible from road.
