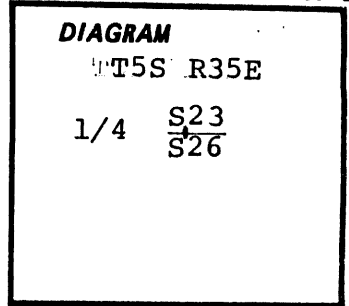


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

In 1882, under Contract No. 451, Rufus S. Moore set a post, from which a 6" Pine bears S32°E, 14 lks. and a 6" Pine bears N25°E, 36 lks.

Description of corner evidence found:

No corner monument or evidence found.

Description of monument and accessories | established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Corner set by single proportioning.
Set 2.5"x30" aluminum capped aluminum pipe rising 6" above ground. Set steel fence post 3.0 ft. north of corner.

Cap is stamped:

T5S R35E
1/4 S23 S26
RLS 1844
1985

New BT's:

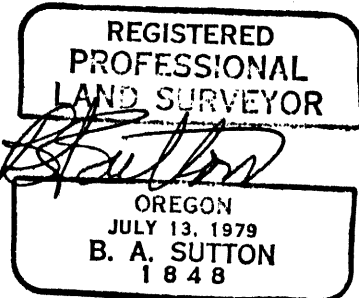
- 8.5" Fir bears N8.5°E, 54.5 ft.,
blazed and scribed: 1/4 S23 BT.
- 6.5" W. Larch bears S53°E, 24.9 ft.,
blazed and scribed: 1/4 S26 BT.

Painted blazes and attached signs as per Standard Specifications for Cadastral Surveys, USFS Region 6, March 1982. Brass disk stamped "LS 1844" nailed to lower end of blazes.

Corner is on east slope above ravine. Road 5100-257 is in bottom of ravine. Take Road 5100-295 to Road 5100-290 to CN1/16 S26, then go north 1/4 mile to corner.
