At the position of the mound I set a 2" galvanized pipe 30" long with bronze cap on top and 8" plate welded to bottom. The pipe set to a depth of 24".

From the monument the bearing trees are; A black pine 18" in diam bears, N33°E 192.4 ft. dist marked ‡SBT A black pine 15" in diam bears 474.3 ft. dist marked ‡SBT; Distance measured to center of trees and marked with a scribe.

I set a steel fence post with USFS sign 54-4 attached. USFS bearing tree signs were placed on the bearing trees shoulder high facing the corner.
