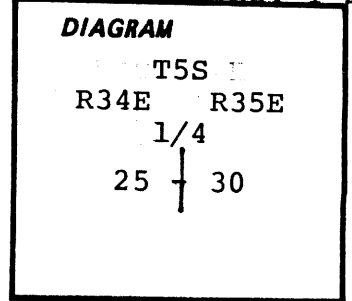


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

The original range line between R34E and R35E was by J. Cooper under Contract No. 397, approved April 15, 1882. Set a post, from which a 26" Pine bears N65°W, 198 lks. and an 8" Pine bears S20°E, 56 lks.

Description of corner evidence found:

No corner monument found. Small pile of rocks at corner location. Notes call for "post".

One bearing tree found: A 34" P. Pine bears N65°W, 130.7 ft. headed face.

Description of monument and accessories established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set 2.5" aluminum cap on 2 3/8"x30" aluminum pipe rising 7" above ground. Cap is stamped:

Steel fence post 3.0 ft. north of corner.

New BT: A 6" Fir bears N87°E, 86.5 ft., blazed and scribed: 1/4 S30 BT.

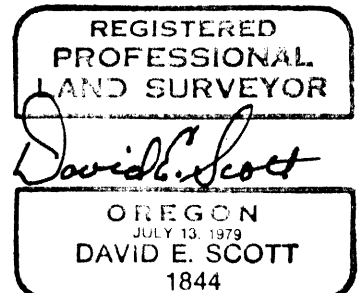
Brass LS 1844 disc in lower end of blazes. Painted blazes and attached signs as per Standard Specifications for Cadastral Surveys, USFS Region 6, March 1982.

Compass Declination: 19 3/4°E Witness: Duane Scott

Corner is found on east side of strip cleared for fine line. 200 ft. south clearing, 1800 ft. south Lookout Cr. 750 ft. east of Rd 5166-065 28 ft. west of fence.
