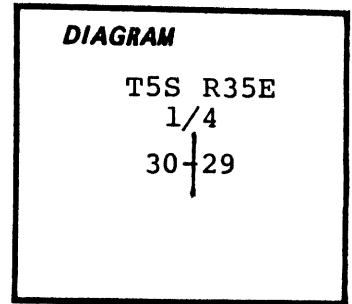


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

Index File No. T-05

History of original corner establishment:

In 1882, under Contract No. 381, Rufus S. Moore set a post, from which a 4" Pine bears N42°E, 86 lks. and a 7" Pine bears S53°W, 48 lks.



Description of corner evidence found:

No corner monument found.

Bearing trees found:

An 18" Pine bears S53°W, 31.6 ft., dead and down, scribed: 1/4 S BT.

Description of monument and accessories established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a 2.5" aluminum cap on 2"x30" aluminum pipe rising 6" above ground. Set steel fence post 3.0 ft. north of corner.

Cap is stamped:

New BT's:

A 9" Tamarack bears S63.5°E, 213.0 ft., scribed: 1/4 S29 BT.

An 8" Fir bears N74°W, 59.9 ft., scribed: 1/4 S30 BT.

Attached brass disk stamped LS 1844 to base of blazes. Painted blazes and attached signs as per Standard Specifications for Cadastral Surveys, USFS Region 6, March 1982.

Corner is found on west side of swampy meadow N37°E, 500 ft. from dam forming pond. Main east-west road through Vey Ranch is 2000 ft. south of corner.

Compass Declination: 19 1/2°E
