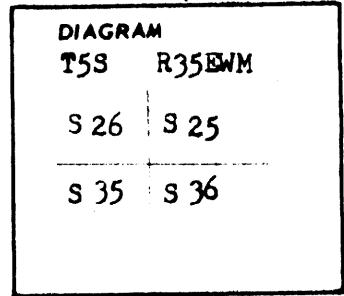

CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

V-21

History of original corner establishment:



Corner established by General Land Office contract survey

The original notes state;

North between sections 35 and 36.

80.00 Set a basalt stone 16 x 8 x 7", 11" in ground for corner sections 25, 26, 35, and 36 from which a;

Pine 4" dia bears N74°E, 28 lks marked T5S R35E S25BT;

Pine 40" dia bears N21°W, 122 lks marked T5S R35E S26BT;

Pine 5" dia bears S50°W, 55 lks marked T5S R35E S35BT;

Pine 8" dia bears S7°E, 95 lks marked T5S R35E S36BT;

Description of corner evidence found:

In section 26, found stump with BT.

At the corner, found ~~stump~~ set along side. the monument.

Found slab with scribing in section 26

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner

At the position of the corner I set a 30" galvanized pipe with an eight inch plate welded to bottom and a bronze cap on top. The hole was back filled with stone and tamped soil.

I stamped the disk.

From the monument the original bearing trees were; (none).

I established the following new bearing trees;

Lodge Pole 14" dia N66°W at a distance of 18.5 ft. and scribed T5S R35E S26 BT

Lodge Pole 12" dia N67°E at a distance of 24.8 ft. and scribed T5S R35E S25 BT

Ponderosa Pine 27" dia S68°W at a distance of 61 ft. and scribed T5S R35E S35 BT

Lodge Pole 10" dia S27°E at a distance of 27 ft. and scribed T5S R35E S36 BT.

The distance measured to center of respective trees on level. I placed bearing tree signs on both old and new bearing trees and painted stripe around trees.

I placed a steel fence post with USFS sign 54-4 attached near the corner and indicated that all four sections were private land.

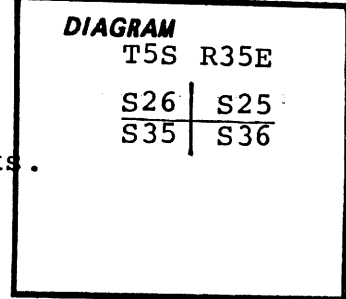

CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Index File No. V-21

In 1882, under GLO Contract No. 451, Rufus S. Moore set a stone 16x8x7 from which a 4" Pine bears N34°E, 28 lks., a 40" Pine bears N21°W, 122 lks., a 5" Pine bears S50°W, 55 lks., and a 6" Pine bears S7°E, 95 lks.



Description of corner evidence found:

Cap is stamped:

Found a 3" brass cap on a 2.5" iron pipe rising 10" above ground.

Found a 45" Stump bears N21°W, 80.5 ft., marked "BT".

Found a 30" P. Pine bears S68°W, 61.0 ft., marked "T5S R35E S35 BT".

Description of monument and accessories established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

New BT's:

8" P. Pine bears N63°W, 86.5 ft., blazed & scribed: T5S R35E S26 BT.

20" P. Pine bears N3°E, 31.2 ft., blazed & scribed: T5S R35E S25 BT.

18.5" P. Pine bears S63.5°E, 41.0 ft., blazed & scribed: T5S R35E S36 BT.

Attached brass disk stamped LS 1844 to base of blazes. Painted blazes and attached signs as per Standard Specifications for Cadastral Surveys, USFS Region 6, March 1982.

Corner is found on edge of timber on east slope above Sheep Creek. Section Line crosses road 51 at driveway to Vey Ranch. Walk 3/4 mile east.

Compass Declination: 19 1/2°E
