

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this gerner

I set a $2^{\rm H}$ galyanized pipe $30^{\rm H}$ long with a bronze cap on top and $8^{\rm H}$ plate welded to bottom. The pipe set to a depth of $24^{\rm H}$ and back filled with stone and tamped soil. I set the wapked stone by the pipe.

I stamped the disk.
