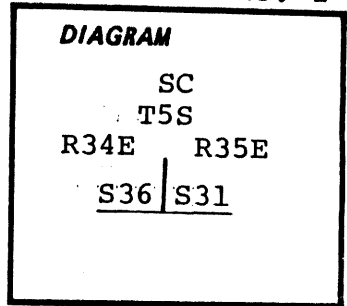


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

Index File No. Z-25¹

History of original corner establishment:

The original subdivision of T4S R34E was by Rufus S. Moore under Contract No. 451, approved February 1, 1884. At this corner he found a post, from which a 30" Pine bears N10°E, 190 lks. The township line between T5S and T6S had been surveyed by J. Cooper under Contract No. 397, approved April 5, 1882.



Description of corner evidence found:

No corner monument found.

Rotted and burnt remains of bearing tree bear N10°E, 125.4 ft., with chopped face, but no scribing.

Description of monument and accessories established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Corner set from evidence. Cap is stamped;

Set 2.5" aluminum cap on 2 3/8" aluminum pipe rising 14" above ground. Set steel fence posts 3.0 ft. north and 3.0 ft. east of corner.

A 9" P. Pine bears N70.5°W, 38.7 ft., blazed and scribed SC T5S R34E S36 BT.

A 15" P. Pine bears N70.5°E, 23.2 ft., blazed and scribed: SC T5S R35E S31 BT.

Brass LS 1844 disc in lower end of blazes. Painted blazes and attached signs as per Standard Specifications for Cadastral Surveys, USFS Region 6, March 1982.

Compass Declination: 19 3/4°E

Witness: Duane Scott

Corner is found on southwest slope, 26 ft., N60°W from fence corner. Oiad 5160-158 to Road 5160-152 0.9 mi. to Track Road, East to fence corner. Road 5160-152 hits fence 0.3 miles north of corner.
