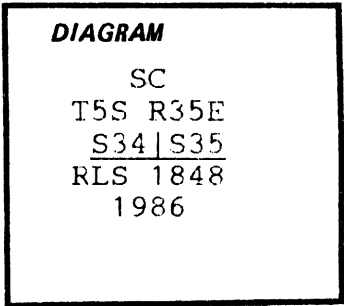


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

None.

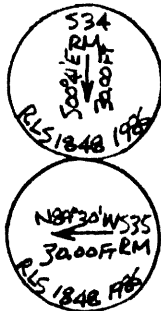
Description of monument and accessories established to perpetuate the
