Description of corner evidence found:

Found 40" P. Pine stump with visible foot blaze and "BT" for S.W. BT. Found 48" P. Pine stump partially rotted with visible foot blaze and "BT". Established a point at record distance from both stumps for corner location.

Could find no evidence of original post.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At established point for corner location set $2\frac{1}{2}$ "x30" galvanized pipe

Set pipe 24" in ground with mound of stone and dirt to cap.
