

CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

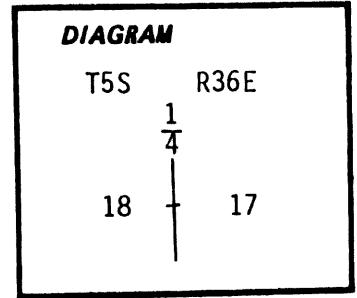

**History of original corner establishment:**

In 1882, under G.L.O. contract No. 452, H. Gradon set post 3 ft. long 3 ins. square, 24 ins. in ground for 1/4 Sec. Cor. marked 1/4 S on W. face from which:

A Spruce 7 ins. diam. bears N75°E 8 lks. dist. marked 1/4 S BT.

A Fir 6 ins. diam. bears S80°W, 9 lks. dist. marked 1/4 S BT.



**Description of corner evidence found:**

At corner location found rotted remains of old original post at record bearing and distance from found White Fir snag rotted off 10" diam. 5 ft. tall for S.W. BT with visible scribing "1/4 S BT" (N80°E, 5.94 ft). Found rotted remains of possible N.E. BT rotted and lying on ground. No scribing could be found.

**Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:**

At original post location set 2 1/2" x 30" galvanized pipe with brass cap stamped:

Set pipe 24" in ground with mound of dirt to cap.

**Bearing trees:**

A White Fir 7" diam. bears N 83 1/2°E, 23.6 ft. scribed 1/4 S17 BT.

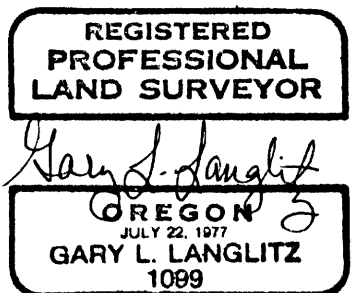
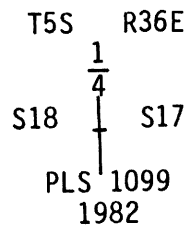
A White Fir 17" diam. bears S56°W, 33.3 ft. scribed 1/4 S18 BT.

Attached signs and painted trees per Standard Specifications for Cadastral Surveys, U.S.F.S. Region 6, October 1979. Attached 54-4 sign to metal post 6 ft. north of corner. Corner falls in botom on N.E. draw on steep north slope.

Compass Declination: 19° E.
