

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Corner position established by survey & subdivision of section 19. At surveyed point set 2 1/4"x30" galvanized pipe with brass cap stamped: Set pipe 24" in ground.

No bearing trees available within 300'. Set 5/8"x30" rebar with yellow plastic cap marked "AP&A" bearing S58 1/2°W, 25.0 ft. Set 5/8" x 30" rebar with yellow plastic cap marked "AP&A" bearing S41°E, 25.0 ft.

Attached 54-3 & 54-4 signs to metal post next to rebar bearing objects. Attached 54-2 and 54-4 signs to metal post 6 ft. South of corner and 54-2 and 54-9 signs to metal post 6 ft. East of corner.

Corner falls on north slope 75' north of top of E-W knoll and 100' south of toe of knoll at meadow in old pole thicket now cut down.

Compass Declination: 19°E
