

No stones available for mound. **S33** A Douglas Fir 7" in dia. bears N50°E, 26.5 ft., scribed 1979 S 1/16 S33BT. OR PLS 1294 A Douglas Fir 7" in dia. bears N46°W, 10.9 ft., scribed S 1/16 S32BT. Attached 54-3 signs to both BT's. Attached brass washer stamped LS 1294 to foot blaze of both BT's. Painted blazes and 6" band around both BT's orange. Attached 54-2 and 54-9 signs to metal fence post 5' South of corner. Attached 54-2 and 54-4 signs to metal fence post 5' West of corner.
