

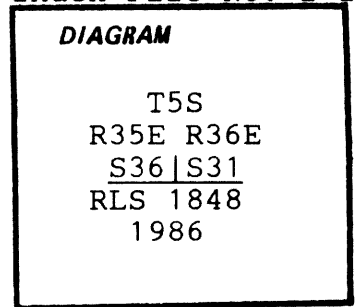

Original corner established in 1881 by Jacob C. Cooper under contract #397.

- A Pine post was set, from which:
- A 24" Pine bears N45°E, 14 lks.
- A 24" Pine bears N72°W, 43 lks.



Description of corner evidence found:

A 35" Pine stump 2½' high bears N72°W, 43 lks., open blaze, BT visible.

Description of monument and accessories | established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Cap is stamped:

Set 2½"x30" aluminum capped aluminum pipe rising 4" in mound of stones. Set steel fence post 3' north of corner.
