

CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

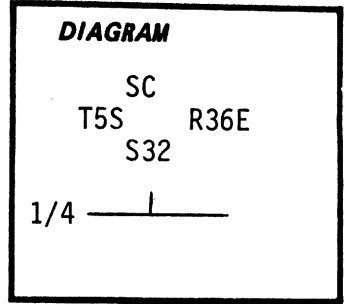
History of original corner establishment:

Corner established in 1882 by H. Gradon, under General Land Office Contract No. 452.

Surveyor General's records state:

Set post 3½ ft. long, 3 ins. square, 18 ins. in ground in a clearing on River bottom for standard 1/4 sec. cor. marked 1/4 S. SC on N. face from which:

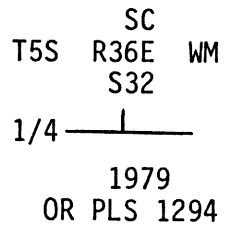
- A Pine 6" diam. bears N70°E, 38 lks. dist. marked S.C. 1/4 S. B.T.
- A Pine 4" diam. bears N21°W, 33 lks. dist. marked S.C. 1/4 S. B.T.



Description of corner evidence found:

A diligent search was made and no evidence of the corner or its accessories could be found.

Description of monument and accessories | established to perpetuate the original location of this corner: At surveyed point established by single proportion measurements set 2½" x 30" galvanized pipe with brass cap stamped:



Set pipe 19" in ground to rock with mound of stone to cap.

From which:

- A Western Larch 9" in diam. bears N19°W, 102.4 ft., scribed 1/4 S32 SC BT.
 - A Spruce 8" in dia. bears N40°E, 26.3 ft., scribed 1/4 S32 SC BT.
- Attached 54-3 signs to both BTs. Attached brass washer stamped LS 1294 to foot blaze of both BTs. Painted blazes and 6" band around both BTs. Attached 54-2 and 54-4 signs to metal fence post 7' West of corner.

I hereby certify the above corner monument was reestablished as herein described on November 1, 1979.
