
History of original corner establishment:

Corner established in 1881 by Jacob C.Cooper under General Land Office Contract No. 397. Surveyor General Record states:

Set post for corner from which;

A pine 16 in. dia. bears N53W, 16 links

A leaning fir 18 in. dia. bears \$64E, 16 links



No record of subsequent remonumentation was found in County records. Description of corner evidence found:

ORIGINAL BTs

A pine 16 in. dia. bears N53W, 10.6 feet, dead and down, scribes visible

A fir 24 in. dia. bears S64E, 10.6 feet, dead and down, blaze evident, not opened

'Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At record bearing and distance from BTs, I set a 2½ inch x 30 inch iron pipe with brass cap marked as shown, 24 inches in the ground from which;


