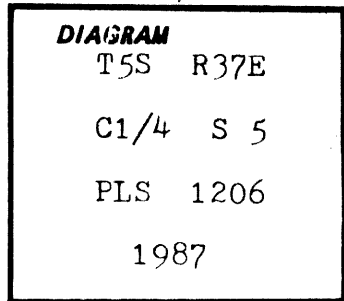


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

C-7

History of original corner establishment:

None, corner established this survey.



Description of corner evidence found:

None.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At the corner point: set a 2½" x 30" aluminum pipe 26" into the ground, with a 36" dia. stone mound around it. 2½" aluminum cap marked as shown in the corner diagram.

From the corner point: (Bearing Trees)

A 9" dia. Ponderosa Pine bears N 69° E at 40.9 ft. dist., mkd. C 1/4 S 5 BT.  
A 13" dia. Ponderosa Pine bears N 78° W at 17.2 ft. dist., mkd. C 1/4 S 5 BT.

Attached U.S.F.S. 54-9 and 54-3 signs to the bearing trees, and painted the face of the blaze and a 6" band around the bearing trees red. Attached a 3/4" dia. I.D. washer, mkd. PLS 1206, between the B and T scribes. Set a steel fence post 4' North with U.S.F.S. 54-9 sign attached. Used 18½° declination on a staff compass for readings to the bearing trees, and used a steel tape to measure to a nail set in the side of the trees at the base.

This corner was monumented to U.S.F.S. specifications on June 25, 1987, witnessed by Tom Fisk, Larry McBroom and Tim Rouse.
