

CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

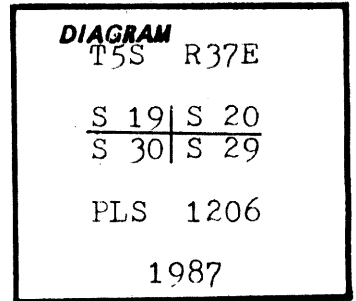

History of original corner establishment:

William R. Gradon conducted the survey of Township 5 South, Range 37 East, W.M., under GLO contract No. 445 dated June 1, 1882.

Gradon set a post for the corner point, from which:

- A black pine 14" dia. bears N 60 W at 47 lks. dist.
- A black pine 4" dia. bears S 45 W at 22 lks. dist.
- A tamarack 8" dia. bears N 35 E at 120 lks. dist.
- A black pine 8" dia. bears S 70 E at 72 lks. dist.



Description of corner evidence found:

BT's-

8" dia. Western Larch bears N 35 E at 79.2 ft. dist., tree is down and partially rotted. Mkd. T5^c /B

No trace of the other three bearing trees.

Description of monument and accessories established to perpetuate the

original location of this corner: Corner point re-established from the one original found bearing tree.

At the corner point, set 2½" x 30" aluminum pipe 28" into the ground, with no stone mound. 2½" dia. aluminum cap mkd. as shown in the corner diagram.

From the corner point: (New BT's)

- A 16" dia. Spruce bears N 65 W at 23.8 ft. dist. mkd. T5S R37E S19 BT
- A 11" dia. Western Larch bears N 23 E At 32.1 ft. dist. mkd. T5S R37E S20 BT
- A 6" dia. Lodgepole Pine bears S 69 E at 34.7 ft. dist. mkd. T5S R37E S29 BT
- A 11" dia. Spruce bears S 38 W at 51.5 ft. dist. mkd. T5S R37E S30 BT

Attached U.S.F.S. 54-9 and 54-3 signs to the bearing trees, and painted the face of the blaze and a 6" band around the bearing trees red. Attached a 3/4" dia. brass I.D. washer, mkd. PLS 1206 between the B and T scribes. Set a steel fence post 4' West with U.S.F.S. 54-9 sign attached. Used 18½° declination on a staff compass for readings to the bearing trees, and used a steel tape too measure to a nail set in the side of the trees at the base.

This corner was monumented to U.S.F.S. specifications on September 28, 1987, witnessed by Tom Fisk and Andy Marlette.
