## CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

William R. Gradon conducted the survey of Township 5 South, Range 37 East, W.M., under GLO contract No. 445, dated June 1, 1882.

Gradon set a post for the corner point,

from which:

A black pine 5" dia. bears N 75 E at 37 lks. A black pine 6" dia. bears S 25 E at 18 lks. A black pine 5" dia. bears S 65 W at 18 lks. A black pine 6" dia. bears N 15 W at 22 lks.

## Description of corner evidence found:

Found rotted post remains at the corner point.

BT's-

A down 7" dia. Lodgepole Pine bears N 15 W at 14.5 ft. mkd. T5S R37E S 21 / BT.

A down and rotted Lodgepole Pine, size indeterminate, bears

S 25 E at 11.9 ft. mkd. R37E S 27 / BT.

A down and rotted Lodgepole Pine, size indeterminate, bears S 65 W at 11.9 ft. mkd. S /.

## Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

In place of the rotted post remains, Set  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" aluminum pipe 24" into the ground, with 36" dia. stone mound around it.  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " dia. aluminum cap mkd. as shown in the corner diagram.

From the corner point: (New BT's)

A 8" dia. Lodgepole Pine bears S 20 E at 39.6 ft. mkd. T5S R37E S27 BT.

A 7" dia. Spruce bears N 3 W at 20.2 ft. mkd. T5S R37E S21 BT.

A 17" dia. White Fir bears N 61 E at 35.7 ft. mkd. T5S R37E S22 BT.

A 8" dia. Lodgepole Pine bears S 51 W at 30.1 ft. mkd. T5S R37E S28 BT.

Attached U.S.F.S. 54-9 and 54-3 signs to the bearing trees and painted the blaze and a 6" band around the bearing trees red. Attached a 3/4" dia. brass washer, mkd PLS 1206, between the B and T scribes. Set a steel fence post 4' East with U.S.F.S. 54-9 sign attached to it. Used  $18\frac{1}{2}$ ° declination on a staff compass to take readings to the bearing trees, and used a steel tape to measure to a nail set in the side of the bearing tres at the base.

This corner was monumented to U.S.F.S. specifications on July 15, 1986, witnessed by Tom Fisk, Larry Mcbroom and Wade Stone.
