## CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

William R. Gradon conducted the survey of Town-ship 5 South, Range 37 East, W.M., under contract No. 445 dated June 1, 1882.

Gradon set a post for the corner point, from which:

A black pine 14" dia. bears N 40 E at 12 lks. A black pine 12" dia. bears S 10 W at 8 lks.

Description of corner evidence found:

None.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the

original location of this corner: After a thorough search of the area revealed no corner evidence, established the proportioned corner point. Set a  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" aluminum pipe with a  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap, 24" into the ground, with a 36" dia. stone mound. Cap is marked

as shown in the corner diagram.

From the corner point: (New BT's) A 18" dia. Spruce bears S. 87° E. at 39.4 ft. dist., mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 27 BT. A 9" dia. L.P. Pine bears N. 64° W. at 31.6 ft. dist., mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 22 BT.

Set a steel fence post 4. East from the monument and attached USFS 54-2 and 54-9 signs. Painted the face of the blaze and a 6" band USFS 54-2 and 54-9 signs. Painted the face of the blaze and a 6" band around the bearing trees red. Attached I.D. washer and USFS 54-9 and 54-3 signs to the bearing trees. Used  $18\frac{1}{2}^{0}$  declination on a staff compass for readings to the bearing trees. Used a steel tape to measure to a nail set in the side of the trees. The 3/4" dia. brass I.D. washer mkd. PLS 1206 was nailed between the B and T scribes.

This corner was monumented to USFS specifications on October 22, 1987, witnessed by Tom Fisk, Larry McBroom and Andy Marlette.
