Attached U.S.F.S. 54-9 and 54-3 signs to the bearing trees, and painted the face of the blaze and a 6" band around the bearing trees red. Attached a 3/4" dia. I.D. washer, mkd. PLS 1206, between the B and T scribes. Set a steel fence post 4" South with U.S.F.S. 54-9 sign attached. Used $18\frac{1}{2}$ 0 declination on a staff compass for readings to the bearing trees, and used a steel tape to measure to a nail set in the side of the trees at the base.
