

CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

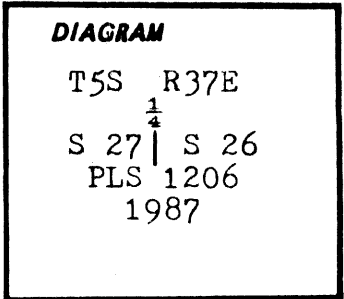
History of original corner establishment:

William R. Gradon conducted the survey of Township 5 South, Range 37 East, W.M., August 14 to August 25, 1882, under GLO Contract No. 445.

Gradon set a basalt stone 18" x 12" x 3", 12" into the ground. Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on West face, from which:

A Pine, 8" dia., bears N. 50° E. at 40 lks. dist.,

A Pine, 10" dia., bears S. 70° W. at 80 lks. dist.



Description of corner evidence found:

Found a basalt stone 18" x 12" x 3" lying with $\frac{1}{4}$ facing upward.

BT's-

Rotted remains of scribe bears N. 50° E. at 40 lks. dist.

Description of monument and accessories established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

In place of the original corner stone, set a 2 1/2" x 30" aluminum pipe with a 2 1/2" aluminum cap, 18" into the ground, with a 36" stone mound. Cap is marked as shown in the corner diagram. The original stone was buried 1' North of the monument.

From the corner point: (New BT's)

A 10" Spruce bears N. 82° E. at 32.4 ft. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S 26 BT.

A 8" Lodgepole Pine bears S. 2° W. at 77.1 ft. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S 27 BT.

Set a steel fence post 4 ft. South from the monument and attached a USFS 54-9 sign. Painted the face of the blaze and a 6" band around the bearing trees red. Attached I.D. washer and USFS 54-9 and 54-3 signs to the bearing trees. Used 18 1/2° declination on a staff compass for readings to the bearing trees. Used a steel tape to measure to a nail set in the side of the trees. The 3/4" dia. brass I.D. washer mkd. PLS 1206 was nailed between the B and T scribes.

This corner was monumented to USFS specifications on August 13, 1987, witnessed by Larry McBroom and Tim Rouse.
