## Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

OREGO (1 SEPTEMBER 25, 1977 JAMES D. HANLEY

At the corner point: set a  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" aluminum pipe 28" into the ground, with a small stone mound.  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap mkd. as shown in the corner diagram.

From the corner point: (New BT's)

A 10" dia. Lodgepole Pine bears S 79° E at 27.9 ft. dist.,
mkd. CS 1/16 S 27 BT.

A 12" dia. Lodgepole Pine bears S 5° W at 9.9 ft. dist.,
mkd. CS 1/16 S 27 BT.

Attached U.S.F.S. 54-9 and 54-3 signs to the bearing trees, and painted the face of the blaze and a 6" band around the bearing trees red. Attached a 3/4" dia. brass I.D. washer, mkd. PLS 1206, between the B and T scribes. Set a steel fence post 4" West with U.S.F.S. 54-2 and 54-9 signs attached to it. Used  $18\frac{1}{2}$ ° declination on a staff compass for readings to the bearing trees, and used a steel tape to measure to a nail set in the side of the bearing trees at the base.

This corner was monumented to U.S.F.S. specifications on Oct. 27, 1987, witnessed by Tom Fisk, Larry McBroom and Andy Marlette.
