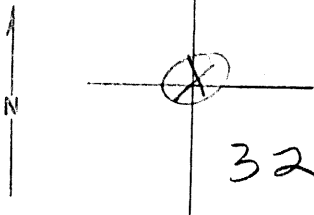

CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

V-5

History of original corner establishment:

William R. Gradon conducted the survey of Township 5 South, Range 37 East, W.M., under GLO contract No. 445 dated June 1, 1882.

Gradon set a post for the corner point, from which:

- A black pine 22" dia. bears N 22 E at 26 lks.
- A black pine 16" dia. bears S 75 E at 60 lks.
- A black pine 15" dia. bears S 40 W at 46 lks.
- A black pine 18" dia. bears N 55 W at 8 lks.

Description of corner evidence found:

BT's-

A 6' long, down and rotted Lodgepole Pine, size indeterminable, bears N 22 E at 26 lks. mkd. 9 BT.

A 3' long, down and rotted Lodgepole Pine, size indeterminable, bears S 40 W at 46 lks. mkd. with visible but not legible scribing.

A 6' long, down and rotted Lodgepole Pine, size indeterminable, bears N 55 W at 8 lks. mkd. T5S R37E S30 BT.

Description of monument and accessories | established to perpetuate the

original location of this corner: At the corner point as re-established from the remains of the three original found bearing trees: set 2½" x 30" aluminum pine 24" into the ground, with 36" dia. stone mound around it. 2½" aluminum cap is mkd. as shown in the corner diagram.

From the corner point: (New BT's)

- A 8" dia. Lodgepole Pine bears S 69 W at 22.3 ft. dist. mkd. T5S R37E S31 BT
- A 9" dia. Lodgepole Pine bears S 78 E at 41.7 ft. dist. mkd. T5S R37E S32 BT
- A 14" dia. Spruce bears N 48 E at 16.9 ft. dist. mkd. T5S R37E S29 BT
- A 14" dia. Spruce bears N 19 W at 34.2 ft. dist. mkd. T5S R37E S30 BT

Attached U.S.F.S. 54-9 and 54-3 signs to the bearing trees, and painted the face of the blaze and a 6" band around the bearing trees red. Attached a 3/4" dia. brass I.D. washer between the B and T scribes. Set a steel fence post 4' North of the monument with U.S.F.S. 54-9 sign attached to it. Used 18½" declination on a staff compass for readings to the bearing trees, and used a steel tape to measure to a nail set in the side of the bearing trees, at the base.

This corner was monumented to U.S.F.S. specifications on August 24, 1987, witnessed by Tom Fisk, Larry McBroom, Tim Rouse and Andy Marlette.
