

CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

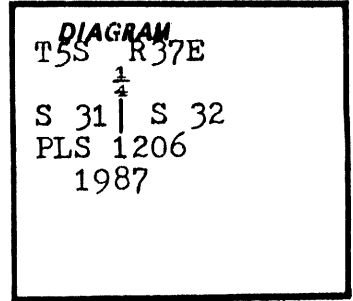

History of original corner establishment:

William R. Gradon conducted the survey of Township 5 South, Range 37 East, W.M., August 14 to August 25, 1882, under GLO Contract No. 445.

Gradon set a post for the corner point, from which: A Black Pine, 14" dia., bears S. 65° E. at 62 lks. dist.

A Black Pine, 14" dia., bears N. 70° W. at 40 lks. dist.



Description of corner evidence found:

No evidence found.

Description of monument and accessories established to perpetuate the

original location of this corner: After a thorough search of the area revealed no corner evidence.

At the proportioned point; set a 2 1/2" x 30" aluminum pipe with a 2 1/2" aluminum cap 28" into the ground. Constructed small stone mound around the monument. Cap is marked as shown in the corner diagram.

From the corner point: (New BT's)

A 12" dia. Spruce bears S. 11° W. at 42.0 ft. dist., mkd. 1/4 S 31 BT.

A 15" dia. Spruce bears N. 52° E. at 30.1 ft. dist., mkd. 1/4 S 32 BT.

Set a steel fence post 4 ft. North from the monument and attached a USFS 54-9 sign. Painted the face of the blaze and a 6" band around the bearing trees red. Attached I.D. washer and USFS 54-9 and 54-3 signs to the bearing trees. Used 18 1/2° declination on a staff compass for readings to the bearing trees. Used a steel tape to measure to a nail set in the side of the trees. The 3/4" dia. I.D. washer mkd. PLS 1206 was nailed between the B and T scribes.

This corner was monumented to USFS specifications on September 15, 1987, witnessed by Tom Fisk and Andy Marlette.
