Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the

original location of this corner: After a thorough search of the area revealed no

corner evidence, established the proportioned corner point. Set $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" aluminum pipe 24" into the ground with 36" dia. stone mound around it. $2\frac{1}{2}$ " dia. aluminum cap mkd. as shown in the corner diagram.

From the corner point: (New BT's) A 8" dia. Lodgepole Pine bears S 75 E at 5.4 ft. dist. mkd. 1/4 S34 BT A 7" dia. Lodgepole Pine bears N 23 W at 146.0 ft. dist. mkd. 1/4 S33 BT

Attached U.S.F.S. 54-9 and 54-3 signs to the bearing trees, and painted the face of the blaze and a 6" band around the bearing trees red. Attached a 3/4" dia. brass I.D. washer, mkd. PLS 1206, between the B and T scribes. Set a steel fence post 4' North of the monument with a U.S.F.S. 54-9 sign attached to it. Used $18\frac{1}{2}$ 0 declination on a staff compass for readings to the bearing trees, and used a steel tape to measure to a nail set in the side of the trees at the base measure to a nail set in the side of the trees at the base.

This corner was monumented to U.S.F.S. specifications on November 5, 1987, witnessed by Tom Fisk, Larry McBroom and Andy Marlette.
