

CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

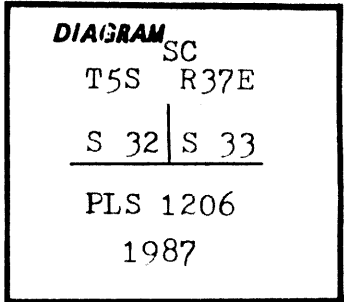

**History of original corner establishment:**

Jacob C. Cooper conducted the survey of the First Standard Parallel Lines of Township 5 South, Ranges 34, 35, 36 and 37 East, W.M., under GLO contract No. 397, dated July 1, 1881.

Cooper set a post for the corner point, from which:

- A black pine 8" dia. bears N 10 W at 4 lks.
- A black pine 6" dia. bears N 75 E at 5 lks.



William R. Gradon, under GLO contract No. 445, marked an additional bearing tree:

- A black pine 14" dia. bears S 10 W at 40 lks.

**Description of corner evidence found:**

BT's-

- A down 12" dia. Lodgepole Pine bears S 10 W at 40 lks. mkd. T6S R37E S5 / BT, on a partially burned blaze.
- A 10" dia. Lodgepole Pine stump rotted flush to the ground, bears N 10 W at 4 lks. Rotted and burnt tree remains lay alongside, both unmarked.

**Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the**

**original location of this corner:** Corner point re-established from the found original bearing trees:

At the corner point, set 2½" x 30" aluminum pipe 26" into the ground, with 36" dia. stone mound around it. 2½" dia. aluminum cap is marked as shown in the corner diagram.

From the corner point: (New BT's)

- A 4" dia. Lodgepole Pine bears N 3 W at 12.8 ft. mkd. X BT.
- A 4" dia. Lodgepole Pine bears N 76 E at 23.3 ft. mkd. X BT.

Attached U.S.F.S. 54-9 and 54-3 signs to the bearing trees, and the blaze and a 6" band around the bearing trees red. Attached a 3/4" dia. brass I.D. washer mkd. PLS 1206 between the B and T scribes. Set a steel fence post 4' East with U.S.F.S. 54-9 sign Attached to it. Used 18° declination on a staff compass for readings to the bearing trees, and used a steel tape to measure to a nail set in the side of the bearing trees at the base.

This corner was monumented to U.S.F.S. specifications September 9, 1987, witnessed by Tom Fisk and Andy Marlette.
