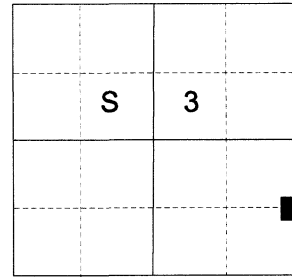

**DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED TO MONUMENT THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:**

At position by survey I set a 5/8" x 30" iron pin, 28" in the ground, with 2 1/2" aluminum cap marked as shown below and in a mound of stone 2' diam.,

From which:

**NEW BEARING OBJECTS:**

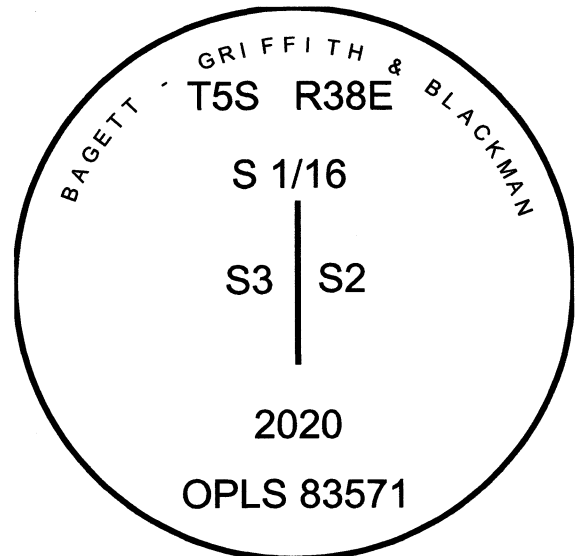
An 18" White Fir bears South 51° East a dist. of 21.65 ft., marked S1/16 S2 BT.

A 17" Douglas Fir bears South 41° West a dist. of 20.70 ft., marked S1/16 S3 BT.

Set steel fence post approx. 1 ft. East.

I hereby certify that the corner was monumented on September 10, 2020.

I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of the new accessories. I used 14° East declination, the distances are to a 60d spike driven into the right side of the root crown of the bearing trees. A brass washer marked OPLS 83571 is attached to the BT blaze of the new bearing trees.
