CHAINS

A fir snag, 11 ins. diam., bears N. 60° W., 2 lks. dist., with illegible scribe marks visible on opened blaze.

At the corner point

Set an aluminum post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/4 ins. diam., 20 ins. in the ground, in a collar of stone, with aluminum cap mhd.
