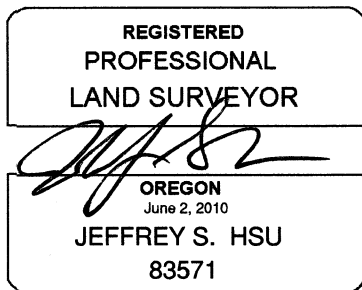
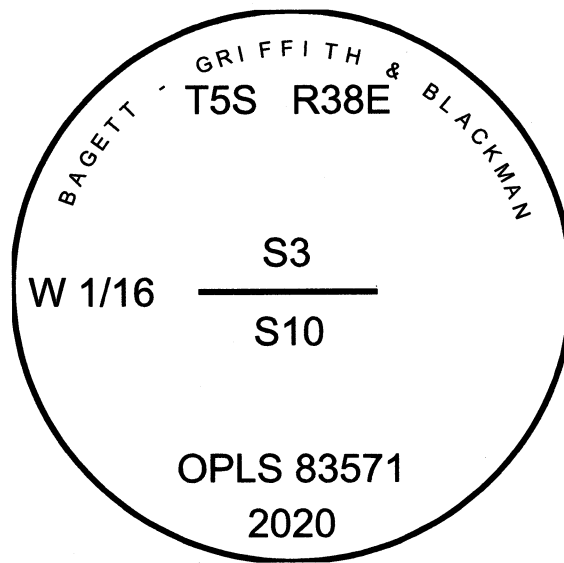
A 13" Ponderosa Pine bears South 7° West a dist. of 49.00 ft., marked W 1/16 S10 BT.

A 16" Ponderosa Pine bears North 26° West a dist. of 13.95 ft., marked W 1/16 S3 BT.

Set steel fence post approx. 1 ft. East.

I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of the new accessories. I used 14° East declination, the distances are to a 60d spike driven into the right side of the root crown of the bearing trees. A brass washer marked OPLS 83571 is attached to the BT blaze of the new bearing trees.
