Corner perpetuated by Scott R. McIntyre under special instructions Group number 1000 for the remonumentation of certain original corners in Township 5 South, Range 38 East dated July 13, 1979. Record states: The 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 10 and 11, monumented with the original basalt stone, 16x14x6 ins., supported by a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, from which the original bearing trees: A Fir, 29 ins. diam., bears S. 55° E., 36 lks. dist. with scribe marks 1/4 S visible on partially opened blaze.
