

A 9" White Fir bears South 19° West a dist. of 9.55 ft., marked W 1/16 S15 BT (tree was formerly used as a fence corner and has remnants of 5 strand barb wire). Engelmann Spruce bears North 29° West a dist. of 20.65 ft., marked W 1/16 S10 BT.

Set steel fence post approx. 1 ft. North.

An East/West bearing fence line falls approx. 2.5 ft. North
