The original corner monument, a basalt stone, approx. 30"x12"x4", now broken, with two sets of chisel markings, 2 notches each, T5S R38E \$22 | \$23 \$27 | \$26 visible on pieces of the broken stone, is lying alongside the iron pipe. Ore. Lic. 381

This corner is located in an area which was severely burned in a recent forest fire.

We find the only remaining original bearing tree, a 24" Ponderosa Pine at the original S.E. position is now a standing snag, all exposed faces have been burned, no marks visible; We find the Voelz 1977 BT's as follows:
