I buried the pipe to within 12" above the surface of the ground. I then placed a large mound of stone four feet dia. and  $1\frac{1}{2}$  feet high about the pipe and covering the monument. From which I set two bearing trees: A pine 5" dia. bears S 48 32 E, 15.00 feet and scribed 1/16S S 35 BT. A pine 5" dia. bears S 34 44 W, 18.70 feet and scribed 1/16S S 35 BT.
