

#### Subsequent Monumentation

Corner was rehabilitated by William B. Barr, under GLO Contract No. 388, approved December 31, 1881.

#### Description of corner evidence found:

Thorough search of area finds no evidence of original corner. Search area has been logged extensively. Corner is determined lost and reestablished by proportionate measurement.

# Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate original location of this corner:

At the position determined by survey, I set a standard USFS 2½ ins. diam. by 30 ins. long alum. post, 24 ins. in the ground with 3½ ins. diam. alum cap, with rock collar, and clear DEEP-1 magnet at base, marked as shown: From which:

An Englemann spruce, 12 ins. diam., bears N. 64° E., 15.1 ft. dist., mkd. 1/4 S31 BT. A lodgepole pine, 6 ins. diam., bears S.  $21\frac{3}{4}$ ° E., 10.4 ft. dist., mkd. X BT on double blaze. An Englemann spruce, 24 ins. diam., bears S.  $22\frac{1}{4}$ ° W., 37.7 ft. dist., mkd. 1/4 S36 BT. A lodgepole pine, 7 ins. diam., bears N.  $39\frac{3}{4}$ ° W., 16.8 ft. dist., mkd. 1/4 S36 BT.

Set guard posts ±6 ft N'ly with Property Boundary (54-2) and Land Survey Monument (54-9) signs, and ±6 ft. E'ly with a Property Boundary (54-2) sign.

All new bearing trees are marked on a single blaze unless noted otherwise and have a nail with a brass washer stamped "LS 2648" right side center for distance measurements.

Painted 6 ins. red bands and added Bearing Tree (54-3) and Land Survey Monument (54-9) signs as needed to all bearing trees.
