## CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION


#### History of original corner establishment:

Original corner set by William B. Barr, under GLO Contract No. 388, approved December 31, 1881.

Record States: Marked Tamarack 12 in. diam for 1/4 sec corner, from which:

Tamarack, 12 inch in dia., bears N 60° W, 19 lks dist.

Tamarack, 15 inch in dia., bears S 86° E, 29 lks dist.



### Description of corner evidence found:

Found corner tree remains supporting proportionate corner position. Scribe marks "/4 S" visible on tree remains, with blank Bearing Tree (54-3) and Attention (54-4) signs attached and a 54-5 marked "Direction XX Bearing XX E 1/4 Date 70". Multiple trees in area with Location (54-5) signs attached. Used distance distance intersection from location signs to set corner in depression, found old flagging while excavating. Found a root hole at approximate bearing and distance for SE tree, bearing tree remains were not found.

#### Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate original location of this corner:

At the above described point, I set a standard USFS 2½ ins. diam. by 30 ins. long alum. pipe, 26 ins. in ground, with 3% ins. diam. alum. cap, and rock collar, with clear DEEP-1 magnet at base, mkd. as shown:

New bearing trees:

A tamarack, 14 ins. diam., bears N. 76° E., 78.4 ft. dist., mkd. 1/4 S32 BT. An Engelmann spruce, 8 ins. diam., bears S. 88  $^{\circ}$  E., 17.8 ft. dist., mkd. 1/4 S32 BT. A lodgepole pine, 7 ins. diam., bears S. 17  $^{\circ}$  W., 8.9 ft. dist., mkd. XBT. An Engelmann spruce, 13 ins. diam., bears N. 30° W., 68.1 ft. dist., mkd. 1/4 S31 BT.

Set guard post ±4 ft. N'ly with Land Survey Monument (54-9) sign attached.

All new bearing trees are marked on a single blaze unless noted otherwise and have a nail with a brass washer stamped "LS 2648" right side center for distance measurements.

Painted 6 ins. red bands and added Bearing Tree (54-3) and Land Survey Monument (54-9) signs as needed to all bearing trees.

I hereby certify that the corner was monumented and accessories taken as described, using a Warren Knight staff compass, set with 15° East declination, and steel tape on August 12, 2014.
