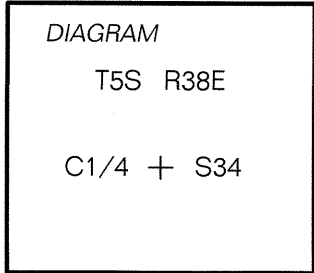


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

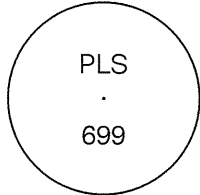
Description of corner evidence found:

At the position established, set a No.5 x 30" rebar with yellow plastic cap marked "PLS 699",

new reference trees established:

- An 8" Ponderosa Pine bears N54°W, 11.68 feet,
- A 10" Ponderosa Pine bears N37°E, 26.05 feet,
- A 7" Western Larch bears S42°E, 26.60 feet,
- A 6" White Fir bears S17°W, 15.03 feet.
