
### CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

# Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate original location of this corner:

At the position determined by survey, I set a standard USFS  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam. by 30 ins. long alum. pipe, 24 ins. in ground, with  $3\frac{1}{4}$  ins. diam. alum. cap, and rock collar, with clear DEEP-1 magnet at base, mkd. as shown:

From which:

A ponderosa pine, 9 ins. diam., bears S. 71° E., 32.9 ft. dist., mkd. XBT. A tamarack, 12 ins. diam., bears S. 24° W., 50.4 ft. dist., mkd. S1/16 S32 BT.

Set guard posts  $\pm 5$  ft. W'ly with Property Boundary (54-2) sign and  $\pm 5$  ft. S'ly with Property Boundary (54-2) and Land Survey Monument (54-9) signs attached.

All new bearing trees are marked on a single blaze and have a nail with a brass washer stamped "LS 2648" right side center for distance measurements.

Painted 6 ins. red bands and added Bearing Tree (54-3) and Land Survey Monument (54-9) signs as needed to all bearing trees.
