

CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

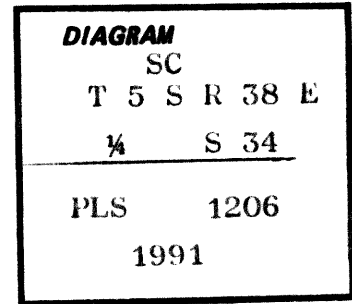

History of original corner establishment:

T. Davenport surveyed the First Standard Parallel South under contract No. 102 dated July 20, 1863.

Record states:

Set post, from which
A Pine 30 inch in diam. bears S. 35° W. 240 lks. dist.
A Pine 8 " " " " N. 88° W. 278 " dist.



W. Barr retraced the First Standard Parallel South under contract No. 388 dated May 7, 1881.

Record states:

Corner destroyed by fire, one tree standing and agreeing with description Pine 30 in diam bears S. 35° W. 240 lks. dist. Reestablished by planting Basalt rock 17 x 12 x 5.

Description of corner evidence found:

Found stone 20" x 10" x 5" set in 36" dia. stone mound, no visible markings.
From which:
An 18" dia., 42" high burnt Ponderosa Pine stump bears S. 35° W., 158.4 feet dist., part of burnt blaze, with some scribing visible but not legible was found lying on the ground beside the stump.

Description of monument and accessories established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At the point previously occupied by the found stone, set 1 1/4" x 30" galv. iron pipe 24" into the ground, constructed 36" dia. stone mound around the monument. 2 1/2" brass cap is marked as shown in the corner diagram.

From which, new bearing trees:

- 1/4 S34 SC BT on a double blaze. A 9" dia. Ponderosa Pine bears S. 77° E., 34.5 feet dist. marked
- 1/4 S54 SC BT on a double blaze. A 13" dia. Ponderosa Pine bears S. 34° E., 62.4 feet dist. marked
- 1/4 S54 SC BT on a double blaze. A 20" dia. Ponderosa Pine with double trunk, bears S. 60° W., 27.1 feet dist. marked 1/4 S34 SC BT on double blaze. Measurements taken to the southerly trunk.
- 1/4 S54 SC BT on double blaze. A 10" dia. ponderosa Pine bears N. 79° W., 71.2 feet dist. marked

Buried original stone 1' north of the monument. Set fence post 2' east of the monument. Attached U.S.F.S. 54-3 signs to the new bearing trees.

I certify that the above corner was properly monumented under my direct supervision on November 6, 1991, as witnessed by Larry McBroom and Mike Parker.
