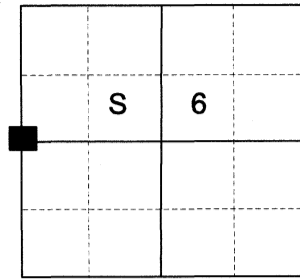


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

HISTORY OF ORIGINAL CORNER ESTABLISHED:

Corner originally under GLO Contract No. 102, executed by Timothy W. Davenport, dated July 20, 1863. Surveyor General field notes state: Set qr. sec. post, made mound of earth and drove charred stake as per inst.

DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND:

Found a 6 ft. diam. pile of stone on West edge of 8 ft. diam. mound of dirt in an area devoid of most stone. Due to the harmony w/ fences to the North, I accept this as being a perpetuation of the original corner.

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At center of found mound of dirt I set a 2 1/2" x 30" aluminum pipe, 28" in the ground, with 3" aluminum cap marked as shown below and in a 4 ft. diam. mound of stone, from which:

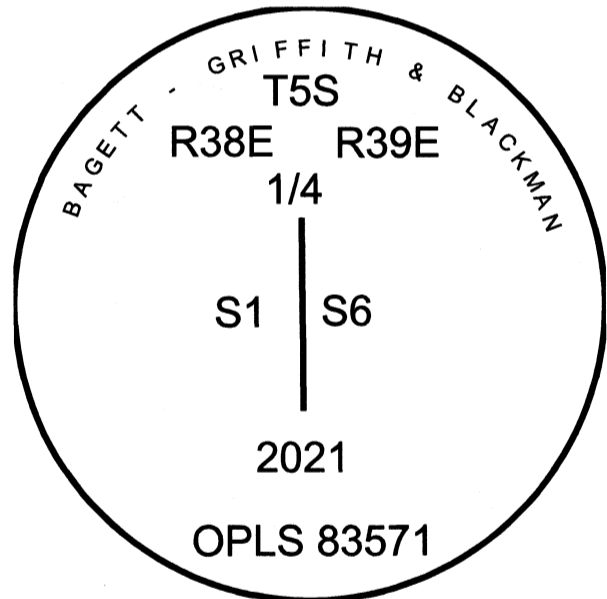
NEW BEARING OBJECTS:

- A 5/8" x 30" iron pin bears North 44°43' East, a dist. of 18.50 ft., with 1 1/2" aluminum cap marked NE RP.
- A 5/8" x 30" iron pin bears South 21°40' East, a dist. of 18.68 ft., with 1 1/2" aluminum cap marked SE RP.
- A 5/8" x 30" iron pin bears South 45°17' West, a dist. of 23.59 ft., with 1 1/2" aluminum cap marked SW RP.
- A 5/8" x 30" iron pin bears North 40°43' West, a dist. of 20.95 ft., with 1 1/2" aluminum cap marked NW RP.

Set steel fence post approx. 1 ft. North
